When Stafford Hopkins loses his high-profile job in network television, his American colleagues rejoice. Canadian-born, his disdain for the industry has outrun his success, and few mourn his departure. His American wife Agnes reluctantly in tow, Stafford retreats to their luxury estate on Maui where he does what he has always done best: rewrite the past. But a year into their exile, Stafford's defenses are crumbling. Haunted by memories of a shameful act against a childhood friend, he pushes away the one person who knows what can and cannot be forgiven: a woman whose name he can hardly bear to say aloud – the mercurial, resilient, uneducated, trash-talking woman he married. Then Stafford receives a letter summoning him home with a request from the dead to do something for the living, and the ghost of Bobby Shepherd can no longer be ignored.

The Maeve sisters must hide their magic and guard their hearts; but as suspicions grow, war looms, and bodies drop, their bonds and beliefs are tested. With the investigation advancing and dangers doubling, the sisters can't help but wonder: what if tracking the strike of the match only results in their burning?




